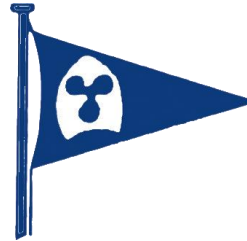

Chris Moyse Memorial Pursuit Race Friday 13th July 2018

1. You are invited to take part in a **FUN** pursuit race event on, **Friday 13th July 2018 In Memory of Chris Moyse Long Time Treasurer and Supporter of the Port of Plymouth Sailing Association**, with the earliest start at 18.30 hrs.
2. Racing will be managed from the PYC start box on the end of Mt Batten Pier; instructions will be given on VHF Channel 37 (M), or Ch 77 if for any reason Ch 37 (M) is unusable.
3. Individual start times will be published on PPSA Yacht Regatta Web Site. Individual start times will be determined from entry information provide, published standard handicap data or by Class Organiser.
4. A countdown to each individual start will be given on Ch 37(M) or Ch 77 if for any reason Ch 37(M) is unusable.
5. Course will be selected from either course A or course B as below. However the Race Officer may decide to use a different course and start/finish lines on the day. In any event, the course will be broadcast on Ch 37(M) or Ch 77 if for any reason Ch 37(M) is unusable .

Start Line will be: Between the PYC flagstaff and West Mallard Buoy Heading South.
Finish Line: Between the PYC flagstaff and the RPCYC flagstaff Heading East.

Course A: Yacht Haven (P), F Buoy (P), Dunstone (P), St Nicholas (S)

Course B: F Buoy (S), Melampus (S), Dunstone (P), St Nicholas (S)

Or as adjusted by Duty Race Officer on VHF

6. *Following Racing:- There will be a Paella Race Supper at the race Village in Yachthaven Marina - competitors and guests welcome. Free Mooring for the evening during the Race Supper within Yachthaven Marina available for Pursit Race Only competitors!!!! Other Regatta Competitors please use allocated berthing.*

The legal bit:

Port of Plymouth Sailing Association is the organising authority and conditions of the Notice of Race (available at Regatta Website will apply to this event. In particular competitors should note that:

1. Racing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing except as modified here.
2. The Dockyard Port of Plymouth Order and Plymouth Local Notice to Mariners shall apply. In particular, regulations regarding the safe navigation of large vessels shall be strictly observed. Yachts shall not pass through The Bridges between Drakes Island and Cornwall.
3. Competitors must agree to their personal responsibilities regarding safety and risk, given in rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing. Third party insurance cover of £3,000,000 is required.
4. Safety boat cover will not be provided.
